# Home Buyer Savings Bill Update FEBRUARY 5, 2019

I look forward to working with Senator Mensch and Senator Fontana when the Home Buyer Savings Bill is introduced in the Senate. The bill that would allow first-time home buyers to deduct from their taxes any money they save for the purchase of a home.

The bill applies to first-time home buyers and those who have not owned or bought a home within three years prior. It allows tax deductions totaling \$50,000 over a 10-year period. Annual contributions would be capped at \$5,000 for single taxpayers and \$10,000 for joint returns.

# Closing Public Pension Loopholes for Felons

Proud to have supported SB 113 in the Senate authored by my good friend Senator DiSanto. It would strip pensions from those that commit felonies while in the work place. The bill never made it to the governor's desk last session, but I look forward to seeing it be signed into law this time.
